Zainabia Welfare Organization is a Hyderabad-based, non-profitable organization, dedicated to humanitarian services, registered as a welfare organization in October 2015. Mr. Nawaz Ali Bhutto and Mrs. Mah Talat along with their daughter Ms. Pareesa Bhutto, lay the cornerstone for ZWO. They used to give back to their community via their own funds, but later in life they made the decision to expand their assistance and incorporate others who might also want to contribute to this worthwhile cause through a registered platform. Ms. Pareesa Bhutto credited her family's involvement in welfare and named this organization in honor of her grandmother, Ms. Zainab. Ms. Zainab was originally from Iran, but she moved to Pakistan after getting married. Utilizing the means she had at the time, she began her life here by providing humanitarian services to the residents of interior Sindh. In addition, she used to engage in various social activities like food distribution, charity, aiding the less fortunate, etc., as well as educating the ladies of the interior about business strategies.

Zainabia strives to reduce hunger, disease, and poverty in the underprivileged areas, especially the slums of Hyderabad, Sindh, under the inspiring slogan "There is no darkness." The committed members of Team Zainabia toil day and night to provide the most afflicted families with a glimmer of hope. It works in many ways from delivering grocery or paying off hospital bills, getting someone to get bedstead or a water cooler and catering to the needs of labors, women and orphans through sustainable financial or non-financial services.

To improve the quality of life for the coming generation, our team aims to transform interior Sindh into a better place. ZWO operates with the assistance of our contributors, who provide monthly donations from registered members, contributions shared through social media, or contributions received through word-of-mouth. We make sure that every rupee donated is used for the intended purpose.

We provide devoted services in the areas of health, education, orphan care, clean water, construction, food, clothing, and other social services.

Whoever you are, wherever you are, Zainabia believes it's time for your voice to be heard!

It's simple to take our basic existence for granted in today's culture with all the rush and bustle that goes along with daily living. Most individuals are comfortable in their daily routines and are hesitant to change them. However, some people aspire to greater heights, whether it is out of desire or the need to survive.

Zainabia met with an inspirational young man who was determined to break the cycle that was inflicted upon him and prioritize his education to lead a better life. Below is Mr. Junaid's story in his very own words:

“My name is Junaid, I am from an underprivileged village of Mirpur Khas, 40 kilometers from the metropolis where all educational institutes are located. Since my family has always made a living by working in the fields, it seemed natural for them to expect the same out of me. I barely passed my matriculation at a government school because in my village, parents prefer to employ their kids in the fields rather than educate them in the school. After overcoming a few obstacles, I enrolled in an intermediate program in the city. I had to travel to the city every day for my college studies, but I could not afford the transportation charges, so I started working at a shop in the evenings simply to be able to pay to finish my studies.

One day while I was scrolling through social media, a non-profit organization named Zainabia Welfare Organization caught my eye. After going through their Facebook page, I saw how enthusiastic they are about performing charitable work and aiding those in need, and I automatically got in touch with them since I wanted to support such a wonderful cause. I ended up sharing my story with them and they instantly welcomed me as a volunteer as well as extended the offer to cover my educational expenses. The organization was generous enough to cover the costs of my one-year computer diploma in addition to covering my transportation costs, which I had seen to be a significant barrier to my study.

Today, I'm able to effectively work from home now with online marketing, and I make enough money to live a more fulfilling life. Zainabia Welfare Organization's assistance has made all of this possible, and it has genuinely made a difference in my life.

They truly mean it when they say, “There is no darkness”, as they literally brightened up my life.

Friday Meal Distribution Project

No one, nowhere, at no time should go hungry.

Our food projects help feed many needy families every month with our 'Friday Meal Distribution'. Every Friday some dedicated volunteers pack boxes (which include fruits, juice, water bottles) and distribute them in hospitals, streets, vendors, orphans, street kids and the needy ones. We also arrange Rice daig on demand of donors and feed people on the street. Meals were distributed every Friday among 2250 people.

Education Project

Zainabia strongly believes that 'Educating is a passport to development'. Zainabia never ceases a chance to sponsor education for the needy ones. For us it's a very noble cause to help a child born in a poor family with this tiny step that may raise him to a better future. 75 students in total were provided with admission fees, school fees, tuition fees, syllabus etc.



Marriage Project

Project Cost

Due to today's rise in socioeconomic prices, parents cannot afford to get their daughters married with dignity and pride and thus allow their daughters to fulfill this crucial rite. In interior Sindh, due to dowry many daughters are rejected which results in many unmarried daughters. Zainabia realizes the difficulty and many poor families were provided with marriage assistance and necessary items were gifted to the bride.

With your generous help, we managed to cater for 31 marriages this year by providing them with furniture and different household items.



Clean Drinking Water Project

Project Cost

It's heart breaking that at numerous places in the farthest, villages of Pakistan people are deprived of clean drinking water. providethemuggles to provide them with water facilities as well as also helps to eradicate those issues that cause the scarcity of clean water.

In total 10 water wells and 48 water pumps have been constructed in Thar and various different villages.



Patient Care Project

Project Cost
Rs. 572967/=

There is a dire need for health services in some of the poorest slums of Sindh region.

Our patient care support helps some of the most deprived areas of Sindh and varies from helping individuals with life-threatening illnesses to supporting monthly medical support.

A total of 33 patients were imparted medical cover for treatments of illnesses such as cancer, brain tumor and other illnesses including medicine bills as well as ambulance services.



Internship Program

A six-day internship program was organized where on day 1-2 the students taught street school kids with collaboration of VHB organization, on day 3-4 the students visited DarulAtfal Orphanage Hyderabad patients and finally on day 5-6 students distributed meal packages among needy people.

Repair and Construction Project

Solely depending on the demand and needs of the family, we help a family to make a basic small home for them. It consists of a bedroom, toilet and, a covered kitchen area. The price varies from 1,00000 to 2,00000 varying accordingly.

We sometimes complete the unfinished structures, like providing roof, doors and windows, toilet or a complete home, whatever is needed to make it a secure basic unit for living. If donors agree to add to its finishes, we proceed further too.

A total of 09 constructions were completed.

Monthly Grocery Project

Zainabia believes 'Everyone has the right to eat, no matter their circumstances' hence every month select houses that really need our help and provide them with monthly groceries.

This year, 47 deserving households were provided with monthly groceries.



Rozgar/Support for Earning Project

In order to empower families, we prefer to give them a tool and encourage them to fulfill their needs by using it.
In total 04 people were granted financial aid or a source of earnings to start their home-based businesses.



Donation Project

Project Cost
Rs. 261930/=

37 donation projects were done in total.
Sewing machines were given to 02 women.
Wheelchairs were provided to 11 disabled individuals.
5 sets of computer table trollies along with chairs were donated to Darul Atfal Orphanage.
A tennis table was provided for kids to play at Darul Atfal Orphanage.
600 blankets, seasonal clothes and other winter essentials were constantly distributed among needy ones.
Snacks were distributed among less privileged kids.
Cold Mineral water bottles were distributed among people on the 10th of Muharram.
Quran Pak and Easy Qaidas were distributed among kids at different underprivileged schools.
Water coolers were distributed among various people in severe heat.
Books were distributed among street school children.

28 deserving families were provided

04 khushi projects were done where people shared their celebrations as in birthdays, events, etc with less fortunate by providing them food and goodies.



Public Toilet Project (Newly Introduced)

Women in under privileged areas do not have access to toilets and are particularly affected by the lack of accessible water, sanitation and hygiene. Zainabia recognizes the problem and vows to fix it as much as possible by building public toilets for women in various underdeveloped areas.

02 public toilets were constructed for the ladies at different villages in Tharparker.



Sale for Charity Project

A variety of needy home-based businesses were helped by providing them with a platform to sale their products and earn.
